## **Does your centre provide bone conducting hearing implants (BCHIs)?**

Since 2011, a national registry has been developed to gather robust information on BCHI users to secure future funding of BCHIs.

The database collects data including numbers implanted, ages, indications, hearing loss, and usage rates.

### **Your contribution is vital!**

Participation in this data collection will raise awareness, inform and provide evidence for BCHI candidates, users, services, manufacturers, and policy around BCHIs.

Each participating centre will have their own data available in graphical form after contributing their data quarterly, and will receive collective findings. It's free, easy to navigate and quick to input data.
