Leadership Training Event for Deaf Young Adults (18-25 years old)

An Ear Foundation Accredited Course

A leadership training course for deaf young adults who want to develop their leadership skills, grow in confidence and use sessions to understand and develop their own strengths.

- **Develop leadership**
- **Investigate change management**
- **Identify barriers, and then strategies**
- **Promote self-awareness and team working skills**

The Ear Foundation works closely with the University of Nottingham.



Leadership Training Event

The Leadership Training Course consists of 4 components:

1. Completion of pre-course questionnaires (June 2017)

These will be used to identify each candidate's current personal and leadership profile

2. 2.5 days residential based training sessions and small group outdoor challenges (July 2017):

Transport: Arrive and Depart from The Ear Foundation

The residential environment enables you to attend a series of led sessions. There will be management and team working activities built into the programme including half a day small group outdoor adventure challenge.

3. 10 hours of mentored practical leadership experiences:

Between August to November you will need to undertake 10 hours of mentored leadership opportunities, you can do this by attending one of the below:

13-18 Aug: Teenagers Residential to Dukes Barn Outdoor Activity Camp

23 Sept, 7 Oct and 11 Nov: Teenz and LEAPing sessions

Agreed local alternatives

A practical opportunity to step out and develop leadership skills while being mentored by course leaders.



4. Written, film or interview based assignment post course (Sept – Nov 2017)

A personal learning summary setting future goals





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Course Presentation

- Spoken English will be used to lead sessions using a mic and sound field system.
- PowerPoint presentations will be used to provide written English and visual information to support listening during sessions.
- Sessions will include:
 - Direct teaching
 - Small group discussions
 - Film clips
